1 RULES

- 1.1 The race will be governed by the *rules* as defined in *The Racing rules of Sailing* and the Sailing Instructions.
- 1.2 Competitors shall wear personal floatation devises, except briefly while changing or adjusting clothing or personal equipment. Flag Y will not be displayed. This changes rule 40.

2 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 2.1 This race is open to any keelboat with an LOA of 18 feet or greater.
- 2.2 Eligible boats may enter by submitting the completed Entry Form and payment (check or cash) to the Race Committee up to 15 minutes before First Warning.
- 2.3 Entry forms and Sailing Instructions can be downloaded from www.sltwyc.com after June 15, 2019
- 2.4 Mail in entries can be sent to: SLTWYC, PO BOX 10466, South Lake Tahoe, CA 96150
- 2.5 Mailed entries must be received by Friday, June28, 2019.

The racing venue will be on Lake Tahoe starting and finishing in front of Tahoe Keys (Coast Guard Mark "O").

- 7 SCORING
Southern California PHRF handicaps for RLC (random leg course) will be used to score the race on a time on time* basis.

- 8 LAUNCHING AND BERTHING
SLTWYC no longer has any association with the Tahoe Keys Marina. We do, however, have several members who can provide dock space (or raft up space) for Friday or Saturday night. For access call Kurt Rasmussen 530 307 0903 at least one week ahead of time.

- 9 AQUATIC INVASIVE SPECIES INSPECTION
Boats coming to Lake Tahoe from elsewhere now require hot water wash and inspection for shellfish on their bottoms and in bilges. For more info: tahoebotainspections.com

We have some great prizes for first and second in spinnaker class, and first in cruising class.
